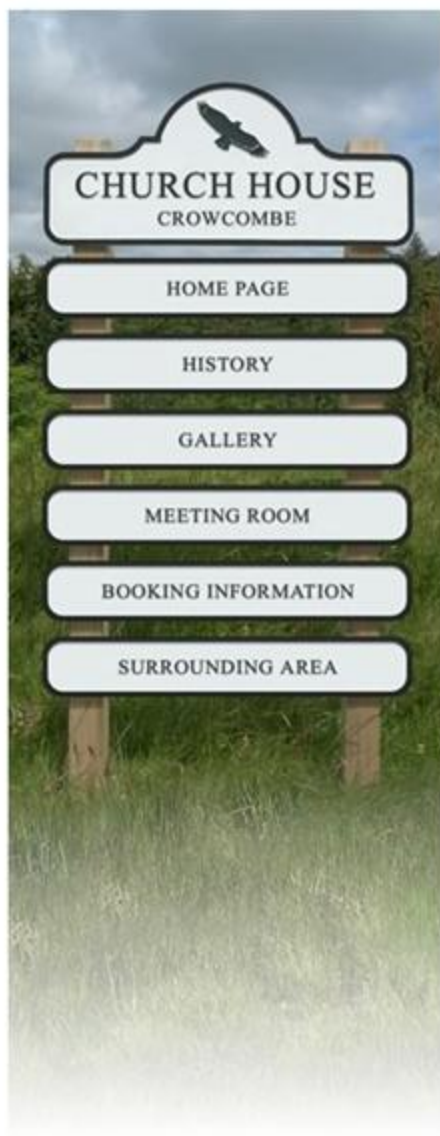

Welcome to Church House, a beautifully renovated 16th Century building situated in the Quantock Hills, in the heart of West Somerset.

Church House is a medieval grade 2* listed building, one of the two surviving church houses in Somerset. It is available as a venue for a wide range of events that would benefit from being held in an historical building of architectural distinction.



Church House has just celebrated 100 years of charitable status and a major £75,000 refurbishment of its facilities.

The facilities now include:

- ~ An upstairs Gallery, with its original 15th/16th century seven bay arch braced purlin roof, used principally for Art Exhibitions and Receptions
- ~ A downstairs Meeting Room
